

of training infrastructure, e-enablement of Panchayats and support of Panchayat processes. RGPSA supports capacity building of Elected Women Representatives. The Expert Committee on Panchayati Raj made recommendations relating to the Central Ministries mainly regarding revision of guidelines of the Centrally Sponsored Schemes for providing appropriate roles and responsibilities to Panchayati Raj Institutions therein. It has also made recommendations for State Governments mainly regarding devolution of powers *i.e.* funds, functions and functionaries (3Fs) to the Panchayati Raj Institutions, social audit and holding regular Gram Sabha meetings etc. The report of the Expert Committee has been shared and discussed with Central Ministries and State Governments.
