

The Second Sanskrit Commission has been constituted in January, 2014 to assess the present status of Sanskrit education in all its aspects and to integrate traditional Sanskrit knowledge into the modern system of education.

The Scheme of Award of 'Certificate of Honour' to honour the eminent scholars of Sanskrit and 'Maharshi Badrayan Vyas Samman' to honour young scholars in Sanskrit are in force. An International Award for Non Resident Indian or a foreigner is also covered under this scheme.

(b) and (c) There is no proposal with the Central Government for making Sanskrit Subject compulsory upto Xth Class in school.

Minority status to Central universities

3422. SHRI PRABHAT JHA: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Central universities which have been granted minority status by Government, so far, State-wise;
- (b) the details of criteria for granting minority status to a Central university;
- (c) whether Government has granted minority status to Jamia Millia Islamia and AMU, Aligarh;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI): (a) to (e) In pursuance of Article 30(1) and in terms of Sections 2(1) and 5(2) (c) of the Aligarh Muslim University (Amendment) Act, 1981, the AMU is treated as a minority institution. Another University, namely, the Jamia Millia Islamia, Delhi has been declared a 'minority educational institution' by the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions (NCMEI). Both the above matters are *sub-judice* before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the High Court of Delhi, respectively.

Vacancies in universities and higher educational institutes

†3423. SHRI NARESH AGRAWAL: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that 40 per cent posts are lying vacant due to non-appointment

of professors in the majority of Government universities and higher educational institutes resulting in continuous deterioration in the quality of education;

- (b) whether Government has any plan to fill the vacant posts of professors;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI): (a) The total number of sanctioned teaching posts in 39 Central Universities under the purview of UGC is 16692 (2316 Professors, 4593 Associate Professors, 9194 Assistant Professors and 589 others) including newly established Central Universities. Out of the total sanctioned teaching posts, 6251 teaching posts are lying vacant (1244 Professors, 2165 Associate Professors, 2769 Assistant Professors and 73 others). A detailed statement of sanctioned and vacant teaching posts in various Central Universities as on 31.3.2014, is given in the Statement-I (*See* below). As regards Indira Gandhi National Open University, the details of sanctioned strength and the working strength is given in the Statement-II (*See* below). The vacancy position in respect of Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs), Indian Institutes of Information Technology (IIITs), Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs), Indian Institutes of Science Education and Research (IISERs), Schools of Planning and Architecture (SPAs) and National Institutes of Technology (NITs) is given in the Statement-III (*See* below). The information in respect of Deemed Universities is given in the Statement-IV (*See* below). The status of faculty position in the State Universities during the Eleventh and Twelfth Plan period is given in the Statement-V (*See* below).

A Task Force was constituted under the Chairmanship of Prof. Sanjay G. Dhande to make appropriate recommendations for alleviating shortage of quality faculty. As per the report of the Task Force submitted on July, 2011, State Universities, Central Universities, Deemed Universities and affiliated colleges are short of qualified faculty to the extent of roughly 40%, 35%, 25% and 40% respectively. An Implementation Monitoring Committee has been constituted by the Government on 23rd January, 2012 to implement and monitor the recommendations of the Task Force.

(b) and (c) Different universities and colleges are adopting different methods/ processes to address faculty shortages in order to ensure that studies of students are not affected. These include hiring *ad-hoc* faculty, appointing temporary faculty, engaging services of retired teachers and engaging visiting faculty etc.

In the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the maintenance of standards in Higher Education 2010, under para 12.2, UGC has clearly mentioned that all the sanctioned/approved posts in the university system shall be filled up on an urgent basis.

Besides, subject to availability of vacant positions and fitness, teachers shall also be reemployed on contract appointment beyond the age of sixty five years upto the age of seventy years. Re-employment beyond the age of superannuation shall, however, be done selectively, for a limited period of 3 years in the first instance and then for another further period of 2 years purely on the basis of merit, experience, area of specialization and peer group review and only against available vacant positions.

While approving the Budget Estimates (Non-Plan) and Revised Estimates, all the Central Universities are exhorted by the UGC to fill up the teaching positions at the earliest.

Further, in order to meet the situation arising out of shortage of teachers in universities and other teaching institutions and the consequent vacant positions therein, the age of superannuation for teachers in Central Educational Institutions has already been enhanced from sixty two to sixty five years *w.e.f.* 23.3.2007.

UGC recently wrote to all the Central Universities to give top-most priority for identifying the causes for the vacancies and make concerted efforts to fill up the vacancies as per UGC norms, at an early date to ensure that the teaching work of the University is not affected.

Further, UGC initiated a scheme called Operation Faculty Recharge for augmenting the research and teaching resources of universities to tackle the shortage of faculty in the university system. So far the UGC has recruited 163 Faculty under this Scheme.

The vacancy of teachers was also discussed prominently in the conference of Vice-Chancellors of Central Universities on 6th and 7th Feb., 2014 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble President of India, in which Vice-Chancellors were exhorted to fill up the vacancies in a time bound manner. As a follow up, the Ministry has written to all the Vice-Chancellors to implement the decision on priority and to furnish an Action Taken Report to this Ministry.
