

Raising of new battalions

3123. SHRI K.B. KRISHNA MURTHY: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Karnataka Government as agreed to provide land to the Border Security Force to raise its new battalion;

(b) if so, the extent of land that the Karnataka Government has agreed to sanction; and

(c) whether Government have taken action to take the land and to raise the new battalion of Border Security Force?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI SHRIPRAKASH JAISWAL): (a) No, Sir.

Raising of Indian Reserve Police Battalion

The reimbursable amount is sanctioned after receiving claims from the States.
