(c) and (d) Yes Sir. The main features of the policy are conservation principles, approach, encouragement of traditional skills and crafts, capacity building, outreach programmes, visitor management, illumination, community participation, disaster management etc. It is followed by the ASI.

Bye-Laws for protected monuments by NMA

1112. DR. CHANDAN MITRA: Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of protected monuments for which the bye-laws have been notified by the National Monuments Authority (NMA) so far,
- (b) the reasons for very slow pace of notifying bye-laws for the protected monuments; and
- (c) the time by when the bye-laws are likely to be notified by the NMA for all the protected monuments in the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CULTURE (DR. MAHESH SHARMA): (a) National Monuments Authority (NMA) has not notified any bye-laws for any protected monument and protected area declared as of national importance, so far, but the heritage bye-laws in respect of Sher Shah Gate and Khairul Manazil Mosque, centrally protected monument, located at Mathura Road, New Delhi, are in the process of vetting through the Ministry of Law. However, present status of heritage bye-laws of the protected monuments and protected areas received in the National Monuments Authority is given in Statement (See below).

(b) and (c) The reasons for very slow pace of notifying bye-laws for all the 3680 protected monuments and protected areas, are due to number of agencies involved in the process of preparing the bye-laws till their notification, namely Archaeological Survey of India, Survey of India, National Monuments Authority, Ministry of Culture and Ministry of Law. As such, no fixed time limit can be indicated for notifying the heritage bye-laws in respect of all the protected monuments and protected areas declared as national importance.
