(c) and (d) Justice Jeevan Reddy Committee in its report submitted to Government on 6.06.2005, recommended repeal of AFSPA and suggested to amend the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 by inserting a new Chapter VI-A in respect of North Eastern States so as to provide for provisions contained in Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act. The recommendations of the Committee are under consideration of the Government.
