Closure of Keshod Airport in Gujarat

*295. SHRI CHUNIBHAI KANJIBHAI GOHEL: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Keshod Airport in Gujarat has been closed;
- (b) if so, when the airport was operational and which type of flights used to operate from there; and
- (c) whether Government is contemplating to restart the commercial activities from this airport?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI ASHOK GAJAPATHI RAJU PUSAPATI): (a) and (b) No, Sir. However, no scheduled operations take place from Keshod Airport. At present, only non-scheduled, chartered and non-commercial flights are operating from this airport. Scheduled flights operated at Keshod Airport till July 2000.

(c) No proposal has been received from any airlines to commence scheduled flight operations from Keshod Airport. It is up to the airlines to provide air services to specific places depending upon the traffic demand and commercial viability while complying with Route Dispersal Guidelines.
