THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI HARIBHAI PARTHIBHAI CHAUDHARY): (a) Under the aegis of Nirbhaya fund, the Ministry of Home Affairs is establishing an emergency response system to attend women in distress. The project involves a total expenditure of $\stackrel{?}{\underset{?}{?}}$ 321.69 crore which includes an implementation cost (one time) of $\stackrel{?}{\underset{?}{?}}$ 102.12 crore and expenses for the central monitoring and evaluation project management unit of approx $\stackrel{?}{\underset{?}{?}}$ 15.32 crore.

(b) to (d) There has been a minor delay in the implementation of the project because the preparatory activities could not be initiated in time. The implementation of the project has been expedited. A Project Management consultant (PMC) has been appointed and discussions with States/UTs have been initiated.
