Advertisements from certain foreign institutions for admission to technical and professional courses have come to the notice of the Government. In order to ensure that quality of education is not adversely affected, the 'Regulations for entry and operation of foreign universities/institutions imparting technical education in India' has been notified on May 27, 2005 by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). The AICTE has released public information in respect of approved institutions both domestic or otherwise.

The AICTE has approved the following two foreign institutes for imparting technical education in India:—

- (i) Institute of Hotel Management, Moulana Azad Campus, Aurangabad in collaboration with University of Huddersfield, UK
- (ii) Asia Pacific Institute of Information Technology, Faridabad Road, G.T. Karnal Road side, Panipat in collaboration with Staffordshire University, UK.

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) Under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan programme (SSA), a Statement showing State-wise expenditure incurred by various States and UTs during 2004-05 is at Statement-I (*See below*). The progress achieved in the implementation of key items of school infrastructure by the State/UT's during 2004-05 is at Statement-II (*See below*). The State-wise progress upto 2004-05 in recruitment of teachers sanctioned under SSA is at Statement-III (*See below*).

(b) and (c) The States of Bihar, West Bengal, Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Sikkim and Delhi had a low rate of overall expenditure during 2004-05. For the same period, the progress in civil works has been slow in the States of Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, West Bengal, Bihar and Orissa. Teacher recruitment has been slow in the States of Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and West Bengal mainly on account of certain Court orders.

The Central Government has taken up rigorous monitoring and review of implementation of SSA in the above mentioned States through monthly and quarterly physical and financial progress reports, review meetings and visits to the States. Focused training and capacity building programmes have also been organised for these States in order to implement SSA more effectively.
