

about 40 students of 2008 and 2009 batches were overstaying in the hostel even after their courses were completed and had vacated the hostels only after administrative action was taken by the Institute. Several incidents of faculty/ employees being threatened, late night parties, theft of valuable equipment, damage of properties by the students have also been reported. The Institute is not able to organize convocation after 1997 and these developments have a direct bearing on the performance of the Institute.

15-Point Programme of Prime Minister

1753. SHRIMATI GUNDU SUDHARANI: Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) progress of implementation of each of the 15-Point Programme of Prime Minister in the country, point-wise and State-wise;

(b) the details of physical targets set and achieved during the period of its implementation, State-wise; and

(c) what action plan the Ministry has formulated on this programme in the Twelfth Five Year Plan?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKHTAR ABBAS NAQVI): (a) to (c) Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the welfare of minorities (PM's New 15PP) is an overarching programme, which covers various schemes / initiatives of different Ministries/ Departments. In order to ensure that the benefits of various Government schemes flow equitably to minorities, this programme envisages location of a certain proportion of development projects in minority concentration areas. Presently 24 schemes/initiatives of 11 different Ministries/ Departments are covered under this programme and are implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs and concerned Ministries/Departments as per the guidelines of individual schemes/ programmes.

While the seven schemes, implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs are exclusively meant for the welfare of minority communities, in respect of other schemes, it provides that wherever possible 15% of targets and outlays should be earmarked for minorities. The State-wise physical/financial targets *viz-a-viz* achievements in respect of seven schemes implemented exclusively for the minority communities in the country and the summary of other schemes covered under PM's New 15 PP during the Twelfth Plan period (2012-13 to 2014-15) are given in the Statement - I to VIII (*See below*).
