economically backward sections amongst the minority communities, if so, the details thereof; and

(b) if not, the steps taken or proposed to be taken by Government to identify the socially and economically backward sections amongst the minority communities?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKHTAR ABBAS NAQVI): (a) and (b) The present schemes/programmes of the Government of India for the welfare of minority communities have been prepared based on the PM's New 15 Point Programme and the decisions taken on the recommendations of the Sachar Committee Report. The data made available by the Census of India 2001 is also used for the purpose wherever required. However, the Census of India 2011, community-wise, data is yet to be published. As soon as the same is published, the Government may take a view on the issue of socially and economically backward sections among the minority communities.

Naming of minority welfare schemes after national icons from minority communities
