#### **National Commission for Human Resources in AYUSH**

1607. DR. T.N. SEEMA: Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY be pleased to state:

(a) the present status of setting up of the National Commission for Human Resources in AYUSH with a view to streamline the education sector in the Indian Systems of Medicine;

(b) the medical and research facilities created for scientific validation of AYUSH system of medicine, State/Union Territory-wise;

(c) the steps taken by Government for inclusion of Ayurveda and Naturopathy into the syllabus of the school education to provide basic knowledge of the system to the students; and

(d) the number of AYUSH gram established as envisages by Government for AYUSH intervention in the healthcare system across the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK): (a) The Ministry of AYUSH decided not to pursue with the idea of setting up of National Commission for Human Resources for AYUSH.

(b) Government of India has created facilities for scientific validation of AYUSH systems of medicine through five (5) Research Councils along with their peripheral institutions under the Ministry of AYUSH namely Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), Central Council for Research in Yoga & Naturopathy (CCRYN), Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine (CCRUM), Central Council for Research in Siddha (CCRS) and Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy (CCRH). State/UT-wise details of facilities are given in the Statement-I (*See below*).

(c) The Ministry of Human Resource Development (HRD) has informed that the content on system of health care comprising of Ayurveda and Naturopathy are integrated in the curriculum at various levels of school education. As per the National Curriculum Frame Work (NCF) 2005 which is a policy document for the country, the textbooks prepared by NCERT, as a follow up of NCF, 2005 reflect the importance of this area. The details are given in the Statement-II (*See below*).

(d) As Health is a State Subject, establishment of AYUSH grams are under the purview of concerned State/ UT Governments. However, under the component of AYUSH services of National AYUSH Mission (NAM), there is provision of financial assistance for AYUSH Gram. Government of India has provided financial assistance to State/ UT for AYUSH Gram as per the details given in the Statement-III.
