- (a) the details of the PSUs under the administrative control of the Ministry;

- (c) the details of SC/ST Employees; welfare association formed by SCs/STs working in these PSUs;
- (d) the details of facilities extended/provided by the Government/PSUs for the SCs/STs welfare association viz., office accommodation, etc; and
- (e) the ways and means in which PSUs/Government involves SC/ST welfare association in the administrative activities/developmental activities/management of the PSUs?

THE MINISTER OF MINES (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR): (a) There are three PSUs under the administrative control of Ministry of Mines:

- (i) National Aluminium Company Limited (NALCO).
- (ii) Hindustan Copper Limited (HCL).
- (iii) Mineral Exploration Corporation Limited. (MECL).
