

Outflow/inflow of FDI

1766. SHRI JESUDASU SEELAM: Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether there has been any outflow or inflow of foreign investment in general and Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in particular to and from the 18 countries which the Prime Minister visited in last one year;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) what has been the value of FDI inflow to India from France and Germany in last one year; and

(d) whether there has been any agreement or MoU signed between India and France and India and Germany in last one year and if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRIMATI NIRMALA SITHARAMAN): (a) and (b) The total outflow and inflow of foreign investment in general for the Financial Year 2014-15 was US\$ 6423.54 million and US\$ 75,716 million respectively. The Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in particular to and from 18 countries which the Prime Minister visited in last one year are as per Statement-I (*See below*).

(c) The value of FDI equity inflow to India from France and Germany in last Financial Year 2014-2015 was US \$ 634.62 million and US\$ 1,124.86 respectively.

(d) The details of the agreement or MoU signed between India and France and India and Germany is as per Statement-II.
