**Rehabilitation of employees of CPSEs from Karnataka and Maharashtra**

1974. SHRI D. P. TRIPATHI:

SHRI B. K. HARIPRASAD:

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) identified

by Government as sick/loss making CPSEs during 2014-15 in Karnataka and Maharashtra;

(b) whether Government has taken any steps for transforming those sick CPSEs into profit making enterprises;

(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;

(d) the number of employees rendered jobless or affected due to the closure or sickness of CPSEs during the last three years and the current year; and

(e) the steps taken by Government for their rehabilitation?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI G. M. SIDDESHWARA): (a) The Public Enterprises Survey for 2014-15 is not finalised as yet however, as per information available in Public Enterprises Survey 2013-14, seven Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) in Karnataka and nine in Maharashtra were sick / loss making as on 31.03.2014 as per details given in the Statement (*See* below).

(b) and (c) After the recommendations of Board for Reconstruction of Public Sector Enterprises (BRPSE), the Government has approved revival of three CPSEs namely HMT Ltd., HMT Machine Tools Ltd. and ITI Ltd. in Karnataka and two CPSEs namely Hindustan Antibiotics Ltd. and Hindustan Organic Chemicals Ltd. in Maharashtra envisaging a total assistance (Cash and Non-cash) of ₹ 6295.69 crore and ₹ 765.62 crore respectively from Government of India. Further, Government has decided in principle for closure of HMT Watches Ltd., Tungabhadra Steel Products Ltd. and STCL Ltd. all three located in Karnataka, as these could not be revived.

(d) During last three years *i.e.* 2011-12 to 2013-14, the number of employees opting for VRS on account of restructuring, sickness, closure etc. of CPSEs is 5073.

(e) As a social safety net measure, Department of Public Enterprises is implementing Counselling, Retraining and Redeployment (CRR) Scheme to the employees of CPSEs opting for VRS even in case of modernization, technology up-gradation, manpower restructuring, closure etc. in CPSEs to equip them with skill/expertise so as to further enable them to avail the opportunities of redeployment and self-employment.
