

Demand assessment for 'Housing for All' scheme

1984. SHRIMATI KANIMOZHI: Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has conducted a base line survey in order to understand the state-wise demand assessment for the scheme for 'Housing for All' by 2022, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the houses to be constructed under the scheme will be accessible to persons with disabilities and take into consideration their infrastructural requirements, if so, details thereof, if not, reasons therefor; and
- (c) whether Government shall take into consideration the safety concerns in disaster prone areas and ensure resilient construction under the scheme, if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO): (a) Technical Committee constituted by Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation has estimated the shortage of houses at 18.78 million in year 2012. The housing shortage is estimated at 20 million by 2022.

(b) The 'Housing for All' mission aims to assist the States/ULBs for providing housing for all eligible families/beneficiaries among the urban poor and comprises four components *viz in-situ* slum redevelopment; Affordable Housing through credit-linked subsidy; Affordable Housing in partnership; and subsidy for beneficiary-led individual house construction.

Scheme guidelines provide that while making allotment, families with physically handicapped persons should be given priority and allotment on ground floor or lower floors.

(c) The mission also includes a Technology Sub-Mission to facilitate State / City Governments to adopt modern, innovative and green technologies for adoption of layout designs and building plans suitable for various geo-climatic zones and to deploy disaster resistant and environment friendly technologies.

People living in urban slums

1985. SHRI K. K. RAGESH: Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any data about the increase of urban slums in India;
- (b) if so, the details of the last five years, State-wise; and
- (c) the data about the number of people living in the urban slums for last three years-number of men, women and children?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO): (a) Decadal Census conducted by office of Registrar General of India (RGI) has data on slum population.

(b) and (c) As per the Census figures, the slum population in the country has increased from 5.23 crores in 2001 to 6.55 crores in 2011. Details giving slum population as per Census 2001 and 2011 and change in population reported over the decade is given in Statement-I (*See below*). Gender-wise slum population and slum population of children in 0-6 age group as per Census 2011 is given in Statement-II.
