- (a) the quantity of foodgrains distributed under the National Food Security Act during the year 2014-15, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (b) the number of beneficiary households that belonged to the SC and ST category?

THE MINISTER OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI RAMVILAS PASWAN): (a) Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) is operated under the joint responsibility of the Government of India and State/Union Territory Governments wherein the responsibilities of identification of beneficiaries, issuance of ration cards to them and proper distribution of foodgrains to the eligible beneficiaries through Fair Price Shops (FPSs) rest with the concerned State/UT Government. State-wise details of allocation of foodgrains under National Food Security Act (NFSA) made by Government of India during 2014-15 are given in the Statement (See below).

The information is being collected from the States and will be laid on the Table of the House.
