Financial allocation to NER

2728. DR. BHALCHANDRA MUNGEKAR: Will the Minister of DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION be pleased to state:

(a) what was the financial allocation to the NER during the last three years ending 31st March, 2015, year-wise;

(b) whether it was equal to ten per cent of the total planned resources as mandatory; and

(c) how much was the actual expenditure, year-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION (DR. JITENDRA SINGH): (a) The total plan allocation for the North Eastern Region (NER) by the non-exempted ministries, including M/o DoNER, during the last three years from 2012-13 to 2014-15 is given below:

In addition, Central Assistance provided under the State Plan, viz. Normal Central Assistance (NCA), Special Plan Assistance (SPA) and Special Central Assistance (SCA), to the eight states of the region during the same period is as under:

(b) As far as allocation under M/o DoNER is concerned 100% of the plan allocation is to be spent for the development schemes for the NER. As regards non-exempted ministries it is observed that earmarked allocation had been marginally lower than 10% of GBS of the ministries.

(c) As per the available information, the expenditure of the earmarked fund for the NER by the non-exempted ministries, including M/o DoNER, had been of the order of Rs. 23643.23 crore in 2013-13 and Rs. 26213.63 crore (provisional) in 2013-14. For 2014-15, compilation of expenditure figures of the earmarked fund by the central ministries not completed. Expenditure of M/o DoNER for 2014-15 is Rs. 1694.80 crore.
