(b) whether it is also a fact that they incurred on the contingency staff, which was unauthorized and in violation of the rules of Government, if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS [GENERAL (RETD.) V. K. SINGH]: (a) Missions have engaged contingency staff from time to time to meet exigencies of official work in accordance with the relevant rules of the Ministry.

(b) Staff engaged on a contingency basis are paid as per prescribed scales.
