THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAPRUDY): (a) Yes, Sir. The National Policy for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, 2015 approved by the Government on 1st July, 2015, seeks to connect entrepreneurs to peers, mentors and incubators. The policy provides for creation of a national network of high quality, screened mentors, leveraging existing network and successful local entrepreneurs, where ever possible.

(b) The Policy has the objective to promote access to finance through appropriate support to venture capital companies, Angel investors and State owned credit agencies.
