

- Central assistance @ ₹ 1.5 lakh per house for EWS category is provided under the affordable Housing in Partnership and Beneficiary-led individual house construction or enhancement.

State Government or their para-statal like Housing Board can take up project of affordable housing to avail the Central Government grant.

(a) how much amount have been sanctioned and utilised for Pune, Nagpur and Mumbai Metro projects since last three years;

(b) whether Government has requested for the sanctioning the metro projects and demanded financial assistance for the early completion of Pune, Nagpur and Mumbai metro projects; and

(c) if so, details thereof and Government's response thereof ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO) : (a) Amount sanctioned and utilized for Pune, Nagpur and Mumbai Metro projects since last three years is as under:

(b) and (c) Yes, Sir. Government of India (GoI) has accorded 'in-principle' approval to the proposal of Government of Maharashtra (GoM) for Pune Metro Rail Project Phase-1 covering a length of 31.51 km along two corridors at a completion cost of ₹11,802 crores. The final/revised Detailed Project Report (DPR) of the said project has not been received in this Ministry from GoM. GoI has already sanctioned Nagpur Metro Rail Project covering a length of 38.215 km along two corridors at a completion cost of ₹ 8,680 crores and Mumbai Metro Rail Project Line-III covering a length of 33.5 km (fully underground) at a completion cost of ₹ 23,136 crores.
