THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO): (a) and (b) Under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM), out of 12,41,427 house sanctioned, 9,29,193 houses are completed and 3,12,234 houses are under construction as on 15.07.2015. States/UTs-wise details of under progress houses are given in the Statement (*See* below).

(c) Government has recently further extended the Mission period of Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP) and Integrated Housing & Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM) by two years, *i.e.* upto 31.03.2017 for completion of on-going projects sanctioned upto March, 20 I 2. During the current financial year, a sum of ₹ 465 crore has been allocated under JnNURM for providing central assistance to the States/UTs for the ongoing projects.
