

Number of Unemployed in Urban Areas

1146. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT: Will the Minister of **URBAN EMPLOYMENT AND POVERTY ALLEVIATION** be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the number of unemployed persons in urban areas of the country has increased over the years;

(b) the details of the urban areas having highest percentage of unemployed persons in relation to their population;

(c) whether Government are considering grant of unemployment allowance to those who have remained unemployed for a specified period;

(d) if so, details thereof; and

(e) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF URBAN EMPLOYMENT AND POVERTY ALLEVIATION (KUMARI SELJA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The estimates of employment and unemployment are available from the quinquennial rounds of National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO). A table showing number of unemployed persons and unemployment rates in urban areas, State-wise, as per the two latest quinquennial rounds of NSSO i.e. 50th and 55th rounds, conducted in 1993-94 and 1999-2000 respectively is enclosed at Statement (See below). The estimates are made on Current Daily Status (CDS) basis.

(c) to (e) There is no proposal under consideration with the Government for grant of unemployment allowance to the unemployed persons. Respective State Governments take decision on grant of unemployment allowance based on the local needs.
