

- (iv) The Government has directed the UGC to ensure effective implementation of reservation policy in the Central universities and those deemed to be universities receiving aid from the public funds.
- (v) During the conference of Vice-Chancellors of Central Universities in February, 2015 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble President of India, the Vice-Chancellors were exhorted to fill up the vacancies in a time bound manner.
- (vi) In the Review Meeting with VCs of Central Universities held on 7th July, 2015, most of the VCs informed that they have already started the process of filling up of vacancies of teachers and a good amount of vacancies will be filled up by end of October, 2015.

Further, the UGC has issued instructions from time to time to all Central and State Universities/institutions for:

- (i) Implementation of the reservation policy of the Government.
- (ii) Display of reservation roster on University website and
- (iii) Filling up of remaining identified backlog reserved vacancies of these categories in both teaching and non-teaching posts.

(a) the number of non-teaching staff in the country under Centrally sponsored Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), State-wise;

(b) the number of employees working on contract basis, State-wise and for how many years they are working on contract; and

(c) the details of scheme for regularization of such employees especially in Jammu and Kashmir?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI): (a) to (c) The Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) is implemented through the State Governments and State Implementation Societies (SIS) that are separately registered societies with staff deputed from the State Government or appointed on contract. Recruitment and service conditions of staff including non-teaching staff and contract employees come under the domain of State Governments and data on this aspect are not maintained Centrally.
