Conversion of rivers into waterways

†775. SHRI VISHAMBHAR PRASAD NISHAD: SHRIMATI KANAK LATA SINGH:

Will the Minister of SHIPPING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the steps are being taken by the Ministry for converting the rivers into waterways;
 - (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) by when it would be possible and the amount that would be required for this entire process; and
 - (d) the details of the model proposed to be adopted for its development?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING (SHRI RADHAKRISHNAN P.): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. A bill for declaration of 101 new waterways as National Waterways (NWs) was introduced in the Lok Sabha during the Budget Session of 2015 which has been sent for examination to the Department-related Parliamentary Standing Committee on Transport, Tourism and Culture.

(c) and (d) The exact model for development of waterways and the amount required for the development will depend on the feasibility study and Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) of related waterways.

Development of Azhikkal Port in Kerala under Sagarmala Project

- (a) whether the proposals were already submitted by Government of Kerala to the Central Government regarding development of the Azhikkal port, Kannur District, Kerala under the Sagarmala project and the first stage of project such as warf and godown facility has already been developed by the State Government as recommended by the Central Government;
- (b) whether Government has taken any steps to include the Azhikkal project under the Sagarmala project;
 - (c) if so, the details thereof and the time frame for completion thereof; and
 - (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

proposal to select Azhikkal Port for development under Sagarmala Programme wherein it has been informed that the Government of Kerala has completed work relating with breakwaters, approach channel and wharf with stackyard. The location of new ports will be decided based on National Perspective Plan.

Proposal to develop strategic port in Iran
