The overall fund allocation to the institute has not reduced except in the current year, which has affected security, sanitation, maintenance of water-electricity Supply, civil works, nursery operations and laboratory maintenance etc. Some essential activities have been reallocated as per functional requirements of the institute.

(c) Additional demand of funds has been proposed by the Ministry in the first batch of supplementary demand for Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education, Dehradun, which manages the Forest Research Institute.

Leopard and tiger safari in Uttarakhand

A project regarding establishment of tiger safari in buffer zone of Corbett Tiger Reserve has been received from the Chief Wildlife Warden, Uttarakhand. While according 'in-principle' approval, the State has been advised by National Tiger Conservation Authority to get the proposal vetted from the Central Zoo Authority and further submit the proposal for consideration. Proposal vetted by Central Zoo Authority has not been received from the State Government.
