### Reduction in fees of Management Institutes

22. SHRI MANOJ BHATTACHARYA: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the previous Government had initiated a proposal to cut down the exorbitant rates of fees in the various Institutes of Management;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether Government would like to push forward the proposal; and

(d) if so, the steps taken/proposed to be taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MD. ALI ASHRAF FATMI): (a) to (d) The Government had decided *vide* orders dated 5th February, 2004 that the fees for the Post-Graduate Programmes (PGP) in the Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) be fixed at Rs. 30,000/- per annum from the academic session 2004-05 and that no other charges/fees should be levied from the students except for mess charges that would be payable by the students separately.

The Government is fully committed to respecting the autonomy of all the institutes of higher learning which have attained excellence. Therefore, the matter regarding revision of fees for PGP in IIMs has been
