Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has decided to set up national cyber crime coordination centre;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with its salient features and terms of reference; and

(c) the steps taken by Government to have centralised online reporting mechanism and create legal and technical infrastructure for cyber crime monitoring, investigation and tackling it?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI HARIBHAI PARTHIBHAI CHAUDHARY): (a) to (c) The Expert Group constituted in the Ministry of Home Affairs to prepare a roadmap for effectively tackling cyber crimes in the country has recommended to set up an Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C) to fight against cyber crimes in the country. This has been accepted by the Ministry of Home Affairs, in-principle, for effective execution of online cyber crime reporting, cyber crime monitoring, setting up of forensic units, capacity building of police, prosecutors and judicial officials, promotion of Research and Development, awareness creation etc.
