Underpasses in Andhra Pradesh

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K. H. MUNIYAPPA): (a) and (b) There are 77 underpasses on NH 5 in the State of Andhra Pradesh out of which, 45 have already been completed and 32 are under construction.

- (c) Underpasses are generally being provided to facilitate movement of local traffic/pedestrians from one side to the other side in a safe manner wherever, the National Highway is passing through urban/suburban/habitated areas and crossing other roads.
- (d) Cost of an underpass varies between Rs. 20 lakhs to Rs. 60 lakhs depending upon its size and site conditions.
- (e) Requests have been received for three more underpasses on NH-5.
