**Model career centre in Osmania University**

1390. SHRI DEVENDER GOUD T.: Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a Model Career Centre has been approved for Hyderabad in Osmania University in Telangana, if so, the details thereof; and

(b) by when it is likely to become operational?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY): (a) and (b) Under the National Career Service Project of the Ministry of Labour and Employment, 100 Model Career Centres were to be set up during the Twelfth Five Year Plan. One such centre was approved to be established in the Employment Information and Guidance Bureau, Osmania University. An amount of ₹ 22.26 lakh has been released to the State Government towards the first installment for establishing this centre. The centres are to become operational during 2016-17.
