

**Fund to Uttarakhand under AMRUT scheme**

†\*133. SHRI MAHENDRA SINGH MAHRA: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the amount of funds provided to states under the “AMRUT” Scheme, the head-wise details thereof;

(b) whether the Ministry is aware that Uttarakhand faces acute water scarcity during the summer season from March to June;

(c) if so, whether the Ministry would provide funds under the “AMRUT” scheme for providing drinking water to various drinking water starved cities of Pauri, Rudraprayag, Dehradun, Tehri, Chamoli, Haridwar, Pithoragarh, Champawat, Nainital, Almora and Udham Singh Nagar districts of the State; and

(d) if not, the list of those cities that were provided funds under the AMRUT scheme?

THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. VENKAIAH NAIDU):

(a) Government has provided funds against approved State Plans for 2015-16 under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) for various eligible components. The Sector-wise details are given in the Statement-I (*See below*).

(b) The Ministry does not monitor seasonal drinking water availability in States/UTs. Under AMRUT, Government performs annual review of service level benchmarks for Mission cities. As per report of State Government of Uttarakhand, none of the six Mission Cities (covered in SAAP 2015-16) had universal coverage of water supply.

(c) and (d) AMRUT provides for financial support to states for taking up urban infrastructure projects in identified Mission cities. For 2015-16, Government has approved State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) of Uttarakhand and released funds for the plan that includes water supply projects in the cities of Dehradun, Haridwar and Rudrapur (Udham Singh Nagar District). Details of the Plan are given in the Statement-II.
