Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that complaints have been received about the large scale corruption in Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Delhi in matters of construction, scholarship and research funds;

(b) the details of construction undertaken and scholarships offered in the last five years therein; and

(c) whether some officials of Vidyapeetha had also been suspended, if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI): (a) Some complaints were received about alleged administrative and financial irregularities, which were found unsubstantiated after due inquiry by a Fact Finding Committee.

(b) The details of construction undertaken by Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha (SLBSRSV), New Delhi in the last five years are as follows:-

- (i) Construction of Karmkand Building of the Vidyapeetha
- (ii) Construction of Administrative Academic Building of the Vidyapeetha
- (iii) Construction of Boundary Wall of the Vidyapeetha
- (iv) Construction of Reading Room of the First Floor of the Library of Vidyapeetha
- (v) Construction of Underground Water Tank of Vidyapeetha

Reform and expansion for admission process in IITs

1351. SHRI ANUBHAV MOHANTY: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the total capacity of students in all the Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) put together in the country and what is the intake annually in every IIT;

(b) the total number of aspirants who appear for the written exam, qualify and actually gain entry in the IITs;

(c) what steps the Ministry is taking to reform and expand access in education, so that the opportunity is increased and more students get admission in institutes like IIT; and

(d) whether there is any proposal to increase the number of IITs in the country in the near future, if so, which are the places and by when?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI): (a) As reported by JEE (Advanced)-2015 Organizing Institute *i.e.* IIT-Bombay, the total intake capacity for undergraduate courses in Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) for the year 2015 was 10,006 (Ten thousand and six). The IIT-wise student intake for the same is given in the Statement (*See* below).

(b) The total number of aspirants who appeared in JEE (Advanced) 2015 for admission in the undergraduate courses in IITs was 1,17,238. Out of which 26,354 candidates qualified and 9,974 candidates got admission during the year 2015 as reported by the examination conducting authority for JEE (Advanced), 2015.

(c) and (d) For further expansion, access and to increase the opportunity for students to get admission in institutes like IITs, the Government has decided to set up 6 (Six) new IITs at Jammu, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka.
