

Review of school text books and curriculum

1228. SHRI T.T.V. DHINAKARAN: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government have set up an Expert Committee to review the school text books and curriculum;

(b) if so, whether Government would consult the State before deciding on the issues so as to have a broader view; and

(c) by when the Committee is likely to submit its report?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MD. ALI ASHRAF FATMI): (a) and (c) Yes, Sir. A panel of eminent historians was set up on 12.06.2004 by the Government to do a quick review of the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) history text books. The panel has since submitted its report.

(b) States, Educational Institutions/Bodies, academicians and experts in the field of education would be consulted wherever it is considered necessary.
