

(b) if so, what is the increase over the last fiscal with action plan to further boost up its earnings; and

(c) whether the Unit also propose to raise the post-retirement benefits to its employees due to higher profits, if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI SONTOSH MOHAN DEV): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The Net Profit of BHEL for the year 2003-04 was Rs. 658 crore as against Rs. 445 crore in 2002-03, which is an increase of 48% in its Net Profit over the previous year.

BHEL is continuously striving to increase its order receipts to ensure steady and continuous growth in earnings. This coupled with cost control efforts is expected to improve the earnings of the company.

(c) At present there is no proposal to raise the post retirement benefits.
