 - * Pre-occupation with household chores, and
 - * Lack of awareness about relevance of Education.
- (c) and (d) In the Elementary Education Sector, Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan

(SSA) has been launched with a holistic and convergent approach to implement Universalisation of Elementary Education in a mission mode with the district focus. The goals of SSA are:—

- * All children in School, Education Guarantee Centre, Alternate School, 'Back-to-School' camp by 2003.
- * All children complete five years of primary schooling by 2007.
- * All children complete eight years of elementary schooling by 2010.
- * Focus on elementary education of satisfactory quality with emphasis on education for life.
- * Bridge all gender and social category gaps at primary stage by 2007 and at elementary education level by 2010.
- * Universal retention by 2010.

The National Literacy Mission (NLM) aims to provide functional literacy to non-literates in 15-35 age group. The thrust areas of NLM are improving female literacy in low female literacy areas, to organize residual illiteracy projects in areas which have substantial number of illiterates and to set up continuing education centres for providing opportunities for life long learning to the neoliterates.
