*206. SHRIMATI SASIKALA PUSHPA: Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has given a grant of ₹1 crore to all State Road Transport Corporations (SRTCs) for augmenting training infrastructure;

MANDAVIYA): (a) to (d) The Government has approved a scheme for Skill development of drivers and mechanical staff in Road Transport and workmen in the Highways construction sector. Under the Scheme a grant of ₹ 1cr. is payable to every training centre for skilling of drivers. Till date 16 such proposals have been approved for training centres at A.P., Karnataka and UP. The skilling of drivers would help in reducing accidents.
