

internet hub at village post offices

1653. SHRI R. SHUNMUGASUNDARAM: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal to provide internet hubs at village post office; and

(b) the number of post offices in rural areas which have e-mail or e-post facilities and how many additional post offices would be provided with these facilities in the current year?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (DR. SHAKEEL AHMAD): (a) No, Sir. There is no proposal to provide internet hubs at village post offices.

(b) The Department has launched e-post service on an all India basis in January, 2004. There are 1,39,081 rural post offices in the country. All rural post offices can provide e-post facilities through their connected e-post transmission centres located in district towns.

(b) whether the construction work of tower being installed to provide Cellone mobile phone service in the rural areas of U.P. has been completed and if not, the reasons therefor and by when, it would be completed?
