Tariff of BSNL and MTNL mobile phones

†*355. DR. PRABHA THAKUR: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether mobile tariff of BSNL and MTNL is equal to that of other private companies; and

(b) the status of utilisation of MTNL and BSNL services in comparison to other private companies?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI DAYANIDHI MARAN): (a) The Telecommunications Tariff Order (TTO), 1999 provides flexibility to all cellular operators including BSNL & MTNL to fix tariffs. Thus, the operators are at liberty to offer alternate tariff packages to subscriber depending upon their usage pattern. There are a large number of tariff plans offered by MTNL, BSNL and other cellular operators. Since there are too many combinations of rentals and airtime charges in various alternative packages, the tariff levels of MTNL and BSNL *vis-a-vis* other private cellular operators, do not provide comparable data for any meaningful conclusion. A broad comparison of one of the tariffs plan for general public of BSNL, MTNL and sample private operator has been made. It is observed that BSNL plan charges Rs. 225.00 as monthly rental, local call charge of Rs. 2.20 & STD call charge of Rs. 2.40 to 3.60 per minute depending upon distance but with a pulse rate of 15 seconds and national SMS charge of Rs. 0.40 per message. The MTNL has a plan with Rs. 100.00 as monthly rental, local call charge of Rs. 1.90 per minute & STD call charge of Rs. 1.90 to 3.90 per minute depending upon distance & type of terminating network with 60 seconds pulse and national SMS charge of Rs. 1.50 per message. The private operator has a plan of

Rs. 200.00 as monthly rental, local call charge of Rs. 1.80 to 2.50 and STD call charge of Rs. 1.80 to 4.00 per minute depending upon distance and type of terminating network with 60 seconds pulse and national SMS charge of Re. 1.00 per message. A sample tariff plan each of MTNL and BSNL are given in the enclosed Statement (*See* below). The tariff plan of MTNL and BSNL are competitive with private operators.

(b) The planning of mobile network is done by the various operators as per their own perception of (i) traffic per subscriber; (ii) usage pattern of subscriber of a particular geographical area; (iii) expected number of subscribers roaming in their network from other networks at a given point of time; and (iv) number of their subscribers who are expected to roam in other networks etc. Therefore, capacity utilization of various operators cannot be compared in wireless systems. However, the market share of PSUs (BSNL & MTNL combined) in mobile telephony is 21.86% as on 31.7.2004.
