

Widening of National Highways

†1746 SHRIMATI MOHSINA KIDWAI Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state

(a) whether Government propose to extend/widen (6 laning/8 laning) all National Highways linking Delhi, like NH 1, 2, 8, 24 and NH-24 (by pass),

(b) if so, the details of all proposed lanes and overbridges including their prescribed time limits for completion, highway-wise,

(c) whether Government are considering any proposal to Lucknow-Delhi Express Highway, and

(d) if so, the details thereof and by when the Highways linking Delhi would be completed?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K H MUNIYAPPA) (a) and (b) National Highways No 1, 2, 8, 10, 24 and 58 are linking Delhi with the adjoining States. The details of stretches where 6 laning/8 laning has been completed/to be carried out are as under

(c) and (d) There is no proposal to construct express highways between Lucknow and Delhi. However, 4-laning of NH-24 from Hapur to Muradabad is scheduled to be completed by December, 2007. 4 laning of Lucknow-Sitapur section of NH-24 is proposed to be taken up on Build Operate and Transfer basis with target for completion by December, 2008.
