

stations have been nominated for installation of CCTV cameras with allocation of budget under Nirbhaya Fund. CCTV cameras have also been installed on a limited number of coaches of passenger and suburban trains on a pilot basis. Sanction for provision of CCTV cameras in 500 coaches has been obtained under the Rolling Stock Programme 2015-16. Work has already been completed in about 25 passenger coaches and 32 suburban coaches (including ladies compartments) that have been commissioned in service.

Dynamic pricing

3489. SHRIMATI JAYA BACHCHAN: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Railways have introduced dynamic pricing in all Rajdhani/Shatabdi/Duronto trains, if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether the fare of these trains is higher than airline fare in some sectors; and

(c) whether Government plans to implement this pricing system for other trains as well, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN): (a) W.e.f. 09.09.2016 Flexi Fare System has been introduced in Rajdhani, Duronto and Shatabdi trains. Under this system, the base fare increases by 10% with every 10% of berths sold subject to maximum ceiling limit of 1.5 times in classes Second AC, Sleeper, Second Sitting (Reserved), AC Chair Car and 1.4 times in 3rd AC class. No change has been made in the fares for 1st AC and Executive class of travel.

(b) In view of variable fare structure, the fare may or may not be higher than Air fares.

(c) At present, there is no such proposal under consideration.
