(c) whether Government are considering to provide special concession to B S N.L's senior citizen subscribers in the monthly rentals;

(d) if so, by when; and

(e) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (DR. SHAKEEL AHMAD) (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The following concessions are offered by MTNL to senior citizen under "Plan 250":—

(i) No registration charges

(ii) 25% rebate in Installation charges.

(iii) 25% rental rebate

(iv) Reduced Security Deposit of Rs 1125/- for local & STD line.

(d) Does not arise in view of (c) above.

(e) BSNL has introduced 'Sulabh Scheme' for all subscribers including senior citizen from October, 2003 under which the rental is substantially lower, ranging from Rs 99/- to Rs. 160/- per month depending on the capacity of exchange system.
