

Food Stamp Scheme under TPDS

1821. SHRI K. CHANDRAN PILLAI: Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any proposal for a Targeted Public Distribution System other than Universal Public Distribution System;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there is any proposal for a "Food Stamp Scheme";
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the number of families covered under Public Distribution System during the last three years, year-wise, State-wise and category-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (DR. AKHILESH PRASAD SINGH): (a) and (b) the Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) is in operation already in the country under which food grains are allocated to the beneficiaries of Above Poverty Line (APL), Below Poverty Line (BPL) and Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) category @ 35 kg of foodgrains per family per month. The Central Issue Price of the foodgrains supplied under the scheme are as under.

(c) and (d) In the Tenth Plan document, the Planning Commission had suggested that a system of distributing food stamps should be tested on a pilot basis. Every eligible family will be entitled to collect its monthly quota of food stamps from a designated distribution center, and such stamps could then be used to buy food grains from any food shop. Accordingly the Finance Minister in the Budget Speech 2004-05 has proposed the introduction of food stamps for the poor on a pilot basis.
