to the pregnant women with the broad objective of reducing Maternal Mortality Rate and Infant Mortality Rate.

AllMS type hospital at Guwahati

1859. SHRI SILVIUS CONDPAN, Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government propose to set up an AIIMS type of hospital at Guwahati to cater the need of the people of Assam and the North-East; and
- (b) what steps have been taken by Government to up-grade the Guwahati Medical College Hospital, Assam Medical College Hospital and Silchar Medical College Hospital as was assured by Government earlier?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRIMATI PANABAKA LAKSHMI): (a) No, Sir. Under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana there is no proposal to set up an AIIMS type institution at Guwahati

(b) The Government has received proposals for upgradation of Medical College Silchar, Medical College Guwahati and Medical College Dibrugarh. Since this Ministry has no scheme for general Upgradation under which these proposals can be considered, these proposals were techno-economically evaluated and recommended to Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (DONER) for funding under Non-Lapsable Central Pool (NLCP) of resources. The DONER has informed that Rs. 8 crores has been sanctioned for upgradation of Guwahati Medical College. The entire amount has been released. The DONER has also informed that Rs. 20 crores has been sanctioned for Assam Medical College, Dibrugarh under NLCP, out of which Rs. 0.22 crores has been released in 2002-03 and Rs. 3.79 crores has been released in 2003-04.
