Persons killed by blueline buses

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI S. REGHUPATHY): (a) 39 persons were killed and 111 persons injured in road accidens due to rash and negligent driving by the drivers of blue-line buses in the National Capital Territory of Delhi during the period from 1st January, 2004 to 30th June, 2004.
