- (c) whether any proposal from the Union Territory Administration has been received in this regard; and
  - (d) the details of funds being allocated under this Mission to the Union Territory?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (RAO INDERJIT SINGH): (a) to (c) Based on the recommendations received from Union Territory of Puducherry, Oulgaret Municipality has been replaced by Puducherry Municipality to participate in the Smart City selection process.

(d) The city of Puducherry is required to participate in Smart City selection Round 3 by submitting its Smart City Proposal (SCP) to this Ministry by 31 March 2017. Funds will be provided to Puducherry subsequent to its selection as per the Smart Cities Mission Statement and Guidelines.

(c) As the approval and appraisal of Metro Rail Projects involve extensive consultations with various Ministries/Stakeholders, no definite timeline can be given for sanction of these projects by Government of India.
