Cobalt Therapy Machines For Cancer Control Treatment

*270. SHRI ABANI ROY: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether several NGOs are playing a useful role with Government assistance under the National Cancer Control Programme, especially in establishing cancer facilities in rural and semi-urban areas;

(b) if so, the number of Cobalt therapy machines which have been installed by them during the Ninth Five Year Plan; and

(c) how Government Plan to support such NGOs during the Tenth Five Year Plan by providing more Cobalt therapy machines for cancer treatment?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. ANBUMANI RAMADOSS): (a) to (c) Under the National Cancer Control Programme (NCCP), financial assistance up to Rs. 1.00 Crore is provided to the NGOs for procurement of various equipment like cobalt Unit, Linear Accelerator, Simulator, HDR Brachy Therapy, Treatment Planning System (TPS) etc. under the Cobalt scheme. A list of NGOs who were assisted under Cobalt Scheme for establishing cancer treatment facilities during 9th Five Year Plan is given in the Statement (See below).

The revised strategy of NCCP proposed for the 10th Five Year Plan lays emphasis on involvement of NGOs for early detection and treatment of cancer through community based activities and strengthening the cancer treatment facilities in Government sector with a focus on reducing the geographical gaps in the availability of such facilities.
