

THE MINISTER OF CULTURE (SHRI S. JAIPAL REDDY): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. Talks between India and Pakistan on "Promotion of Friendly Exchanges in Various Fields" were held in New Delhi on August 3-4, 2004 within the framework of the Composite Dialogue. The Indian delegation was led by Secretary (Culture) and the Pakistan delegation led by Mr. Jalil Abbas, Secretary, Ministry of Minorities, Tourism, Culture and Youth Affairs.

(c) and (d) Yes, Sir. Views were exchanged on liberalizing the visa regime and expanding the scope of the 1974 bilateral Protocol on Visits to Religious Shrines by increasing the number of pilgrims and shrines on both sides.

(e) Both sides made wide ranging proposals for promoting friendly exchanges and cooperation in the fields of art, culture, archaeology, education, science and technology, youth affairs and sports, media and tourism.

#### Celebration of birth of Khalsa

THE MINISTER OF CULTURE (SHRI S. JAIPAL REDDY): (a) to (d) For commemoration of 300th year of birth of Khalsa, the Government had made a total allocation of Rs. 77.95 crore till financial year 2003-04. Out of this, an amount of Rs. 65.58 crore was released to State Governments, Universities and Non-Governmental Organisations for creation of permanent assets and for undertaking various programmes. A list of major projects on which funds were spent is given in the Statement.
