1681. SHRIMATI RENUKA CHOWDHURY: Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Bhutan has backed out of the Bhutan, Bangladesh, India and Nepal (BBIN) Motor Vehicle Agreement;
 - (b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor; and
 - (c) the steps taken by Government to go ahead with the project without Bhutan?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI MANSUKH L. MANDAVIYA): (a) to (c) Bhutan, being one of the signatories to the Bangladesh, Bhutan, India and Nepal (BBIN) Motor Vehicle Agreement (MVA), has not yet ratified the BBIN MVA. Pending ratification, however, Bhutan has given its consent for the BBIN MVA to enter into force for the other 3 countries i.e. Bangladesh, India and Nepal, who have already ratified it.

Status of eastern peripheral expressway

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI MANSUKH L. MANDAVIYA): (a) to (d) The works for Eastern Peripheral Expressway have been awarded in six packages and scheduled date of completion is March 2018. There is no delay.
