Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship has been implementing two flagship schemes known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) and Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) on pan –India basis to cover the prospective youths for taking Short Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) through accredited and affiliated training partner/training centers.

PMKVY 2016-20 aims to train one crore youth for 4 years (2016-2020) with a total outlay of ₹ 12,000 crore. Under the scheme, the trained candidates are either placed in various sectors or self-employed. Under PMKVY, as on 1st December 2017, 39 lakh (appx.) candidates have been trained/undergoing training in the country. Under PMKK, Ministry is promoting establishment of model aspirational skill centres in every district for imparting skill training through PMKVY. As on 1st December 2017, 523 PMKKs have been allocated in 484 districts across the country.

Under PMKVY 2015-16, 900 cr. has been spent for the training. No Statewise allocation has been made under the scheme. The PMKVY 2016-20 scheme has two components namely Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSCM) and Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM). Under CSCM component, an amount of 550 cr. and 710 cr. has been allocated for FY 2016-17 and FY 2017-18. No Statewise allocation has been made under this component.

Under Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM) component, 25% of the funds and corresponding physical targets of PMKVY has been allocated to the States. Under CSSM component, an amount of 149.99 cr. and 300 cr. (appx.) has been sanctioned/released to respective Skill Development Mission/implementing agency for FY 2016-17 and FY 2017-18. The State-wise sanction of fund under CSSM is given in the Statement.
