Demand to solve the Problems being faced by Fishermen of Tamil Nadu

SHRI E.M. SUDARSANANAT CHIAPPAN (Tamil Nadu): Mr. Chairman Sir, I want to talk about the problem faced by Tamil Nadu fishermen. Sri Lankan Navy arrested Tamil Nadu fishermen along with mechanished boats and country *vallam*. They were later released. But the boats were not given to them. About 33 boats are on the shores of Sri Lanka. When they delay in returing to the fishermen, they become useless. Hence, Government of India should take immediate steps to get back the boats belonging to Rameshwaram fishermen. Further, Permanent steps should be taken to avoid recurring occurrence in Kachchatheevu islands. Thank you.
