1725. SHRI PRASHANTA NANDA: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) how many families have been covered under the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) in various districts of Odisha, district-wise details thereof; and

(b) how many beneficiaries have availed/taken second refill in the financial years 2016-17 and 2017-18, till date, district-wise details in Odisha thereof?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN): (a) As on 30.07.2018, more than 30.48 lakh LPG connections have been released under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) in the State of Odisha. District-wise details are given in the Statement-I (*See below*).
